

Maintenance Technician

Summary/Objective: The Maintenance Tech is responsible to support and maintain the building, systems, equipment, tooling, and properties of the company.

Reports to: Maintenance Supervisor

Essential Job Responsibilities: Reasonable accommodations will be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Maintenance Technician Responsibilities:

- Work with the Supervisor to complete scheduled preventative maintenance (PM) tasks.
- Work with the Supervisor to maintain/repair tools and equipment.
- Work with the Supervisor to maintain/repair the mechanical, plumbing, or electrical systems of the building.
- Work with the Supervisor to maintain/repair the structure of the building and exterior grounds.
- Work with outside contractors to maintain/repair the building, equipment, tooling, systems, and properties, when required.
- Follow safe work practices and model safe work behavior at all times.

Required Education and Experience:

High School Diploma or equivalent. Excellent safety and attendance record. Mechanical aptitude.

Preferred Experience:

1-3 years of experience working in a shop/manufacturing environment
