A Customer Service Technician is primarily responsible for general maintenance, mechanical, hydraulic and electrical diagnostic and repair of fire apparatus in the field. The process itself encompasses the initial analysis, troubleshooting and review of a claim or issue and then, working closely with our customer, dealer, or sales rep, bringing the claim to a final and satisfactory disposition.

- Manage warranty incidents that may arise with HME Ahrens-Fox fire apparatus in the field
- Trouble shoot and problem-solve mechanical, electrical, pneumatic, and hydraulic issues that may arise
- Support the HME Ahrens-Fox sales and service network as required
- Cross functional interaction with production, engineering, quality, sales, and supply chain
- Support for Service Parts Sales & HME Ahrens-Fox service bulletins as required
- Respond to phone calls
- Respond to email inquiries
- Warranty claims processing
- Parts research through Bill of Materials
- Review of part prints and schematics
- Review of parts failure analysis mode
- Enter Line Problem Resolution reports
