 - Pinion: Install the pinion into the carrier and perform a final check on the preload
 - Final Build: Perform the final steps to assembling the differential by installing power divider, checking input play and sealing the unit
- Cross-train on alternate assignments and perform duties in other work areas as needed
- Work with team members to achieve daily goals
